Dear CRJW Friends,

Over twenty years ago, the Center for Restorative Justice Works began its mission to unite children, families and communities separated by crime and the policies of the criminal justice system.

In our 2019 Annual Report, we share with you the successes of CRJW's five programs which address the needs of the children, families, and communities of the incarcerated. Get On The Bus, the only California state-wide program of its kind, remains our signature program, representing the lion's share of children and families served.

At CRJW, we understand that children are a society's most valuable resource, and that every child wants and needs to know that a parent loves them no matter where that parent might be. CRJW programs serve as conduits to assist and accompany children, families and communities in crossing over the barriers that separate them from their incarcerated loved ones.

GOTB stories from children about spending their day with their incarcerated parents show the true impact of CRJW's GOTB program. As one guardian noted: Angela is 16 years old, vision-impaired, and has not connected with her mother in 12 years. When asked how she was feeling, Angela replied, "I really don't know what to expect, so I'll take anything." Once in the visiting room, she was enveloped in a big hug, and Angela and her mother spent the afternoon huddled together, talking non-stop, and feeding each other bits of their sandwiches. As the visit drew to a close, Angela hugged her mother and pressed her mother's hand to her heart. She was beaming. She shared, "You know, I don't believe in happy endings. They aren't realistic and you always end up getting hurt. But sometimes, you get exactly what you need."

Please know that without your continuing support, volunteer and financial, CRJW's success and fulfillment of its mission would not be possible. We thank you for that support which allows us to help children of the incarcerated and their families "get exactly what (they) need."

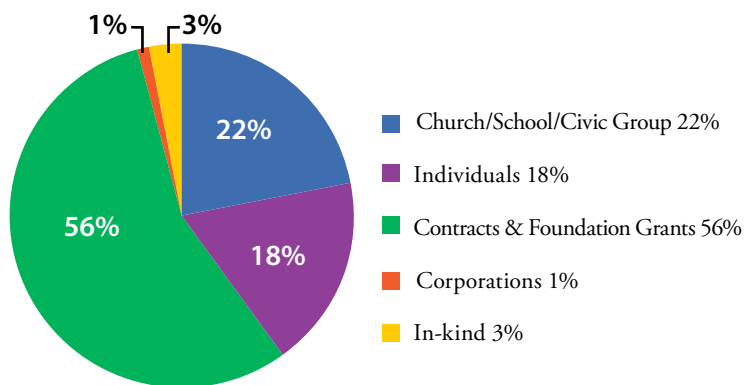

Financial Stewardship

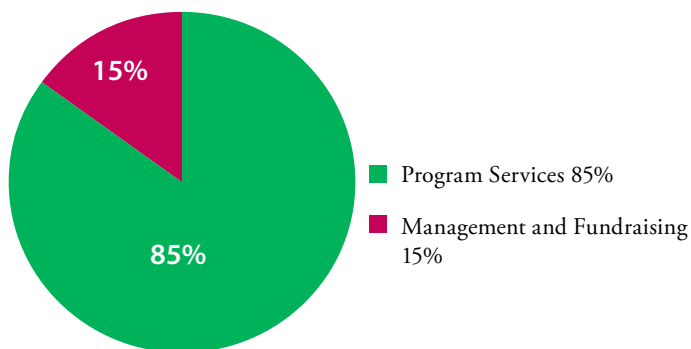
Each year, the Center for Restorative Justice Works raises funds through its generous grassroots network that reaches across California. Each donation adds a compassionate voice to our movement to unite children with their parents in prison. This is the story of a mother's unconditional love and support.

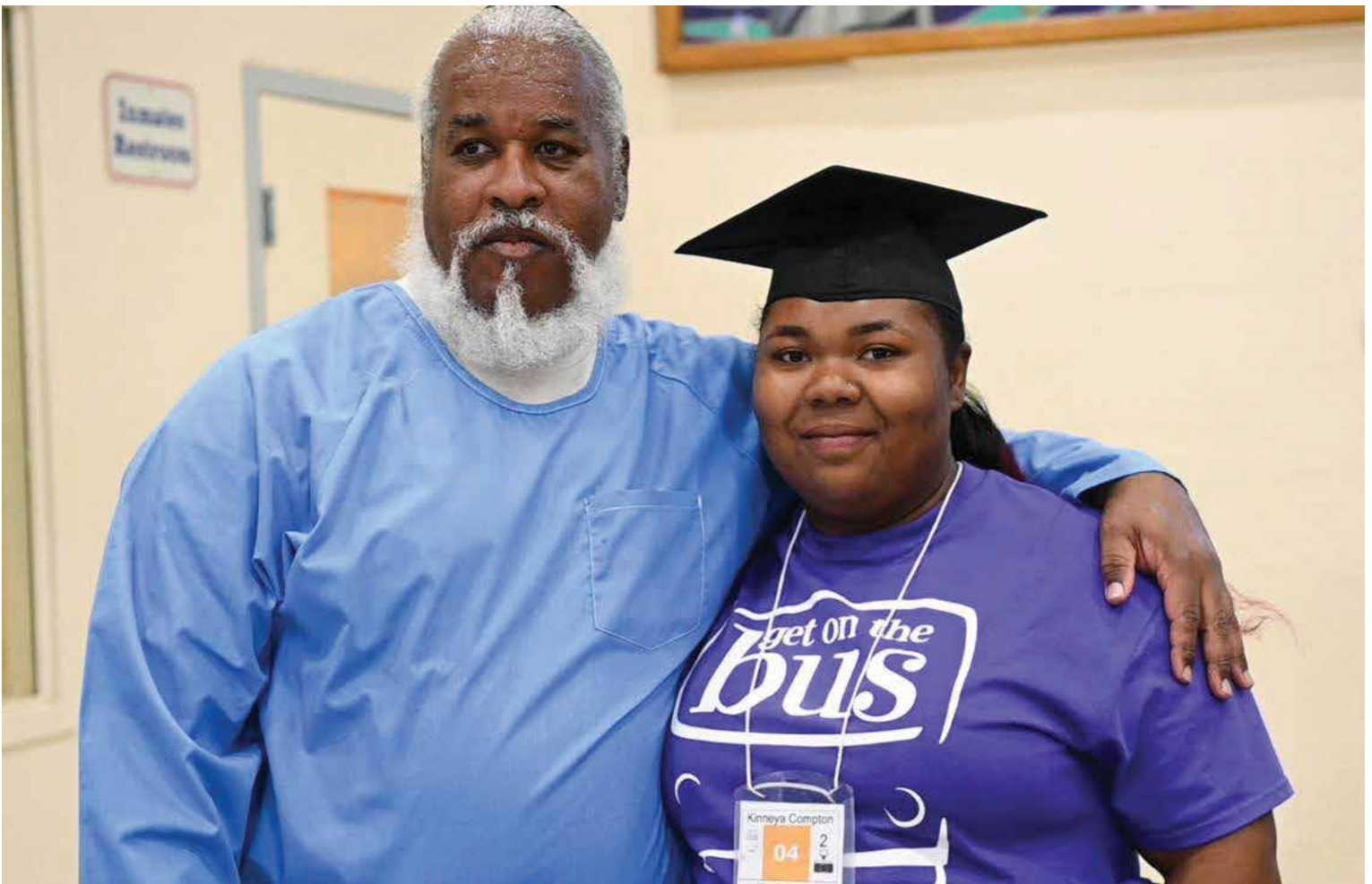
Ms. Darlene, a grandmother of three, was a participant who rode the Family Express bus regularly to visit her daughter Sequoia, who was serving a life sentence. Late one afternoon, Ms. Darlene called ecstatic and breathless with excitement, and said, “Your services are no longer needed.” Still in shock, she informed the team that Sequoia was released from prison after serving seven years of a life sentence. Ms. Darlene expressed that her family was never under the impression that her daughter would be released. She shared, “We visited her to provide support, to love her, and provide guidance. Each visit felt great walking away, knowing we would return in one month. It was a wonderful feeling.”

Once released, Sequoia shared, “I don't know where to start; for one, I felt very happy knowing they were coming down because I was able to sit down and talk face to face. I felt happy, grateful, and thankful because my mom has many health issues, and she would come with my kids. It helped me do my time, and I appreciate everything you've done for us.”

Our mission for family and community reunification could not be possible without the partnership and support of the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation, Hospitality Bus Leaders and volunteers. Milestone for Grad, Proud Moment for Dad

The echoes of an excited crowd filled with vigor and bliss are recognizable to us all when we remember the moment our names were called at our high school graduation. Our tender minds, focused on the incredible energy of a joyous crowd, realize that our twelve-year journey has come to a successful end. The excitement of taking on a new endeavor is under the guise of fear and nerves. We search the crowd for that nod of support from our loved ones but find a conspicuous void glaring back at us. These are the distinct moments when we need to be assured that everything will be fine, and the sun will still rise tomorrow. These are not rare moments for children who have loved ones in prison.

This year's GOTB event at Folsom State Prison had one of these moments. Kinneya, a vibrant young lady whose father has been in prison for most of her life, graduated from high school in June 2019. Kinneya knew her father would miss this significant occasion yet wanted to share this incredible milestone. The GOTB event at Folsom was conveniently scheduled two days after her graduation. Through the advocacy of our committed volunteers and the incredible partnership with the institution, Kinneya was allowed to confidently wear her graduation cap when she visited her father.

As Kinneya walked into the visiting room on that warm Saturday morning, she saw her father's welled-up eyes and elated smile fill the room with extreme joy. Everyone in that visiting room noticed Kinneya's father glow with delight. It was evident that he was very proud to see his little girl in her graduation cap, perhaps reminding him that his baby was all grown up.

Though her dad was not present to see Kinneya proudly walk across the stage at her graduation, he was able to share a snippet of glee that was felt on that special day. On the day of the GOTB event, Kinneya's dad embraced her and told her how very proud he was of her accomplishment and stood beside her as she now stepped into adulthood. Kinneya and her father were able to cherish that special moment and commemorate it with pictures and a celebratory meal. As they held one another, smiling big and sharing their happiness, it reminded the Get On The Bus staff and volunteers of its purpose, the loving effect it has, and the seamless moment of a true blessing.



Camp Suzanne

Camp Suzanne provides a rare opportunity for the child of a mother in prison to create and reinforce sustainable family bonds, as well as to nurture the concept of being part of a family unit. The Camp is a week-long program with a combination of art and family support with a multidisciplinary approach. Through simple conversations, while working on art projects or playing games, mothers experience rare moments of just being moms, listening to and encouraging their children to dream. Camp volunteers lead and participate in a variety of fun, traditional summer camp activities: swimming, hiking, campfires, games, and more!

One camper shares camp experience:

This was my first time with camp. I didn't even know something like this existed for people like me. But, I was happy it did. Just because my mom made a mistake, it doesn't mean that she stops being my mother. I still want to have a relationship with her. I need to have a relationship with her. I never thought I would have such an experience like camp. I was so nervous on that first day. **I got to see, feel and be held by my mom. It wasn't a dream.** It was real and I got to do it again the next day. I was able to ask questions that I have been wondering about for such a long time. Questions that only my mom could answer. I didn't always like the answer, but my mom was honest, and it helped build trust between us. Our bond is so much stronger, and I can't wait till she comes home. We have a whole new future waiting for us. **We are family,**



and that is important. Thank you to Camp Suzanne for making me feel special and that my mom and I matter. WE matter. Camp Participant, 16 yrs.

Rekindled Love for Life, Work, and People

Transition4Success provides employment and training opportunities for formerly incarcerated individuals at the Center for Restorative Justice Works headquarters. Our mission is to support positive post-prison outcomes for returned citizens by giving them a sense of self-worth, while also helping them adjust back into normalcy. Participants receive six-months of paid, hands-on experience working in a modern office setting, along with coaching and feedback in an environment that supports their successful transition.

After serving 26 years in prison, Gilbert Cardenas shares his journey.

Words cannot describe what Transition4Success has done for me. It is unbelievable! The program expanded my computer, communications, and interpersonal skills. I was involved in several projects where my ideas and feelings were respected and regarded just as much as those of the CRJW Team. My resources and networking also grew, and the program has helped me to achieve my educational and employment goals.

What touched and moved me deeply was the respect and dignity the CRJW staff afforded me. They have rekindled my love for life, for work, and, most of all, for people. My transition back into society has been fulfilling, positive, and successful. I am so grateful for the encouragement, support, and care, primarily through my trials, fear, and anxieties. Thank you for your faith in me and for helping me to trust again and to be trusted. My experience with Transition4Success will forever have a place in my heart.
